creator Aaron Korsh. Led by Arrow's Stephen Amell, Suits L.A. will focus on Ted Black, a charismatic former prosecutor who runs a Los Angeles firm that specializes in criminal law, he's about to give original sharp-dressed lawyers Harvey Specter and Mike Ross (Gabriel Macht and Patrick J. Adams, left) a run for their money. The legal drama, which aired on USA from 2011 to 2019, also starred Rick Hoffman, Gina Torres, Sarah Rafferty, Abigail Spencer and Meghan Markle (yes, the Duchess of Sussex), and it has since found a fresh audience thanks to streaming. When the first eight seasons arrived on Netflix last year—all nine seasons can be found on Peacock—the show landed at No. 1 the Nielsen streaming charts almost instantly, surprising even the cast with its overnight success. Although the new pilot will exist on its own in the Suits universe, we can't help but wonder if surprise guest stars are in store. And will Amell match up to the sartorial elegance of his predecessors? We'll be seated patiently in the courtroom waiting to be called to order. —Andrea Towers

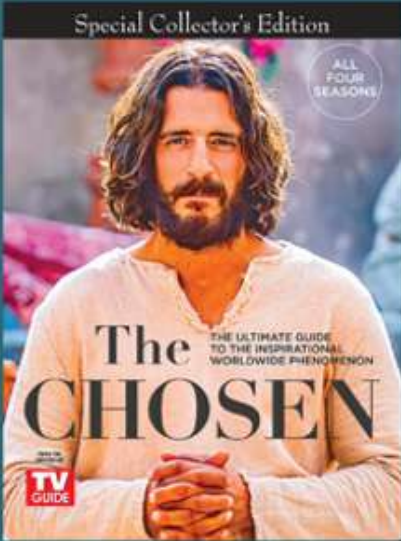

Sanada rides high as Lord Toranaga

Shogun

They don't make epics like this anymore—until they do, magnificently

A “RELIC FROM a bygone era”—that’s how *Shogun*’s hero, cunning Lord Yoshii Toranaga (the mesmerizing Hiroyuki Sanada), refers to the military title he insists he doesn’t covet. (We know better.)

FX’s majestic 10-part *Shogun* could also be seen as an emblem of another time, when maxi-sized miniseries (today’s “limited series”) were regular events, now a seemingly lost art like that of the star-driven variety show or the weekly *Twilight Zone*—style anthology. In 1980, the first time TV tackled James Clavell’s mammoth and hugely entertaining historical novel, with miniseries king Richard Chamberlain as the star, *Shogun* was rightly acclaimed as a peak achievement of the sprawling format.

This ambitious remake, told largely in Japanese with lucid subtitles, deserves its own shower of praise. Thrilling and fascinating in its depiction of an ancient, exotic and often forbidding culture, *Shogun* immerses us in the world of 1600s feudal Japan through the eyes of an outsider: English sea pilot John Blackthorne (the likably blustery Cosmo Jarvis), stranded in this strange land amid a tempest of political intrigue and deadly power plays.

The difference is that this adaptation shifts its primary focus from the white “barbarian” to the so-called “godless savages” whose customs he struggles to understand, even as Toranaga

takes the *Anjin* (pilot) under his wing as a strategic tool in his ongoing battle against his many devious rivals. Comparisons to *Game of Thrones* are inevitable, given the scope of the battle scenes on land and sea, the shocking betrayals and reversals, and the complexity and density of its labyrinthine narrative.

Any dragons here are purely symbolic, of course. Which doesn’t mean the characters don’t take flight. They’re a vivid tapestry of noble and ignoble warriors led by the seemingly outnumbered Toranaga, the jovially double-dealing Yabushige (scene-stealing Tadano-bu Asano) and especially the lovely, conflicted Lady Mariko (Anna Sawai), a Catholic convert assigned as Blackthorne’s interpreter.

Torn between her new faith and her duty to Toranaga, skillfully threading the needle between old and new worlds while adhering to the samurai code of death before dishonor, Mariko embodies the strengths and contradictions of a nation on the cusp of irreversible change. I never wanted to leave this world. Please, FX, never stop aiming this high. ★★★★★

The Regime

HOLLOW LIES THE head of state in *The Regime*, a rare HBO misfire that’s too heavy-handed and cynically predictable to score as political satire and too silly to resonate as an allegory of dangerously despotic government. Luckily, this *Regime* is ruled by Kate Winslet, who won two Emmys for previous HBO projects (*Mildred Pierce* and *Mare of Easttown*). She’s ravishing even when asserting, “I am very much not ridiculous” while she’s being absolutely bonkers. This series’ idea of absurdist humor is to make the delusional Chancellor Elena Vernham’s perimenopausal hot flashes so extreme that she sends the entire palace into a deep freeze.

Over six episodes, the vain, paranoically phobic and childish petulant Elena—who we’re supposed to believe was once a physician—manages to ruin her unnamed Central European nation, prized for its agriculture and mining. She propels it into civil war after falling under the Rasputin-like spell of an unstable and violent soldier (intense Matthias Schoenaerts) whom she inexplicably plucked from obscurity. Soon, he’s insinuated himself into her tut-tutting cabinet and eventually her bed, as his populist reforms mutate into a cruel authoritarian nightmare. It would feel timely if it weren’t all so tiresome. ★★★☆☆

The Walking Dead: The Ones Who Live

Sundays, 9/8c, AMC
(through March 31)

IF ABSENCE TRULY makes the heart grow fonder, watch out when those star-crossed soulmates from *The Walking Dead*, natural-born leader Rick Grimes (Andrew Lincoln) and warrior goddess Michonne (Danai Gurira), finally reconnect after years apart. Given the nature of this grueling horror phenom, it’s hardly a surprise that their reunion is the opposite of a meet-cute, when she nearly takes his helmeted head off.

The continuation of this enduring love-amongst-the-zombies story is complicated by Rick’s unwilling conscription into the monolithic Civic Republic Military. Michonne has her own reasons for despising the CRM, and the opening chapters of the six-part *The Ones Who Live* that chart their disparate and desperate journeys toward each other are as compelling as anything we’ve seen from the franchise in ages. This is easily the best of the spinoffs to date, because of our intense connection to these bold characters and their desire for each other. (Plus: that whole absence/heart factor. We missed them.) ★★★☆☆

What’s your take on *Flower* (Sheila Carrasco) being “sucked off” to heaven in *Ghosts*? Some people seem to be mad about it, but ever since the cliffhanger, I felt it had to be a character the audience would miss, and I respect that they followed through on it. —*Jake*

MATT ROUSH: I agree. If it had been (as Pete put it) “just a basement ghost,” it wouldn’t have been as effective. My criterion for a show killing off a character—including one who’s already passed—is that the event must have impact on those left behind. That’s definitely the case here. And yes, I’ll miss this daffy hippie spirit as well.

I was pleased to see Michael Weatherly’s cameo as Tony on NCIS’s farewell episode for David McCallum’s Ducky. With the show spreading into international markets (e.g., Sydney), does this pave the way for a European spinoff for Tony and Ziva (Cote de Pablo) running a team together? —Sam F.

MATT ROUSH: At this point, such an idea is purely wishful thinking, but the reality is that the sky’s the limit when it comes to maximizing popular network franchises. So keep dreaming.

I thoroughly enjoyed your miniseries countdown (“Best of the Classics,” February 19), though I’d argue *Lonesome Dove* deserved the No. 1 spot. One glaring omission: the star-studded 1983 three-night event of *Chiefs*, a lasting memory of my childhood. —Matt V.

MATT ROUSH: *Dove* is also a personal favorite, but you can’t deny the cultural impact of *Roots*. And yes, *Chiefs* was another good one. The list of great miniseries could go on forever.

THE BOLD AND THE BEAUTIFUL

The *Bold and the Beautiful*'s Sheila Carter, one of soaps' most notorious villains, has come to a grisly end, stabbed to death by her daughter-in-law with a butcher knife. Kimberlin Brown, the actress who returned to *B&B* as Sheila in 2021, admits she's had to work through her feelings about her exit. "Moving into my sixties, it's like I finally found myself and I have found my happiness," Brown begins. "And happiness is when I'm working, happiness is when I'm on set, happiness is when I'm being Sheila, so knowing that's come to an end, it's a sad time for me. I can't lie about that."

Brown, who made her 1990 debut as Sheila on *The Young and the Restless* before crossing over to *B&B* in the same role two years later, knows to expect the unexpected when it comes to her alter ego. "I never take anything for granted with my character because she has been here a year, gone a year, here two years, gone three—that sort of thing," she explains. "As much as I love playing my part, I never really have that security that a lot of other actors have on the show,

especially if you're playing a good girl." Nevertheless, Brown enjoyed her most recent run to its fullest. "It's been a wonderful return," she raves. "Sheila is always unpredictable, which is what I love about my character. The writers gave me such great material since the day I came back."

So she aimed to be positive when playing out Sheila's murder. "I tried my best to be lighthearted about it," Brown reveals. "I've seen people before when they exit, and they're very angry. I can't be angry because I've been so blessed to play my character as long as I have."

And though Sheila has defied death before, Brown isn't so sure about a resurrection this time. "If you watch the aired shows, I don't know," she sighs. "This one might be tough to come back from."

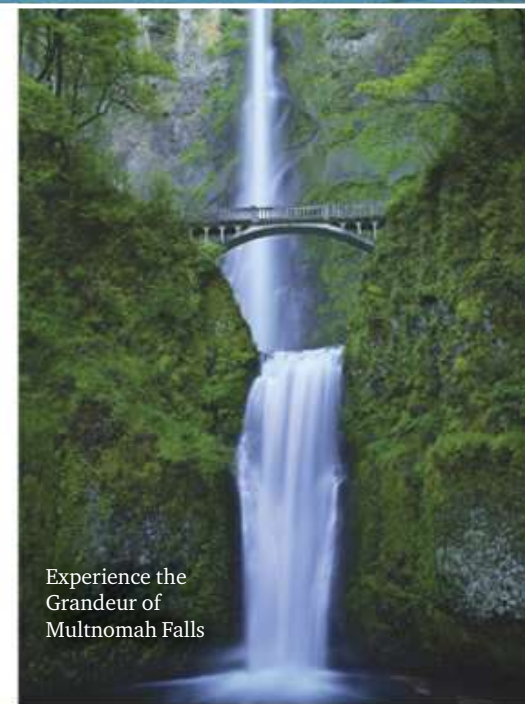

Scandal alum Tony Goldwyn arrives on *Law & Order* as the new Manhattan DA. But can he fill Sam Waterston's shoes?

MEET NICHOLAS BAXTER, played by actor-director Tony Goldwyn, who succeeds Sam Waterston's über-ethical Jack McCoy as Manhattan district attorney. McCoy recently retired—with a push from the mayor—after decades in the DA's office, and Baxter joins in the March 14 episode eager to make some changes in his department. Goldwyn, a self-admitted fan, shares what to expect.

Congratulations on becoming *Law & Order*'s new DA! You're back in politics

after playing the U.S. president on *Scandal*. I guess you don't mind the demotion? No, no. [*Laughs*] The interesting job description is all that matters. **This isn't your first experience in Dick Wolf's popular crime show franchise, right?** I'm not a stranger to the *Law & Order* ecosystem. I directed an episode in 2006 of the mothership and the next year, I had a four-episode arc on *Criminal Intent* [during Seasons 6 and 7] as Frank, the crack-addicted brother of Det. Robert Goren [Vincent D'Onofrio].

How did the new role come about? I'd heard [the producers] were discussing me, and my agents asked if I might be interested. A couple of years ago, we had a conversation about a potential spinoff. It didn't happen, but it [seemed] that it would be a fun thing to do. Dick Wolf maybe had me in mind again. I got together with showrunner Rick Eid, and what they came up with sounded really interesting, so we decided to go for it. **How does it feel to follow in Sam Waterston's footsteps?** I feel very honored.

Baxter will take on some "highly flammable" cases, says Goldwyn

Sam is an iconic actor. I had the privilege of directing him and admire him for what he has meant to *Law & Order* and television for so long.

How does Baxter get the job to replace McCoy? The New York governor appoints Baxter, but in a year or two, he'll have to be elected or he'll be out of a job.

What can you tell us about the character? Baxter is from a political dynasty—

with a senator in his family. He worked in the DA's office early in his career, then was a very successful litigator in private practice. Fifteen years ago, he went back into public service in the Southern District's U.S. Attorney's office. Despite being to the manner born, he's the real deal—a bright, accomplished guy who is acquainted with New York's power players.

How will he differ from McCoy as DA? McCoy was a purist, following whatever the law said on a case-by-case basis. Baxter, who may have larger political

ambitions, takes into account the social, political and longer-term systemic implications of a high-profile case.

What does that mean? He looks at the public good as opposed to [only] the case's narrow merits. For example, he takes into consideration the broader social impact of prostitution.

Baxter meets detectives Jalen Shaw (Mehcad Brooks) and Vincent Riley (Reid Scott) even before he sees his staff. Why? On the day he's appointed,

he sees a crime scene, and out of unbridled enthusiasm, he just walks in to tell the cops hello and say he wants to work with them—which is a surprise to Shaw and Riley, and probably a bit unwelcome.

How does he get along with his team, especially Executive ADA Nolan Price (Hugh Dancy) and ADA Samantha Maroun (Odelya Halevi)? Both Maroun and Price are in a period of evaluation as to whether they have the same worldview that Baxter does as he builds a team he can trust. There's no overt hostility, but Price was interim acting DA after McCoy left, so I'm sure he's skeptical of Baxter and doesn't know whether he'll

have a job at the end of the day.

What can you share about your first episode's case? A successful young guy in finance has been murdered, and the prime suspect is close to another powerful person who is implicated in a different major crime. It's complicated and immediately becomes very high-profile and at the top of his priorities.

Your roles in TV, movies and onstage are really

diverse, from *Ghost*'s villain to the voice of Disney's Tarzan. What draws you to a project? It's about who I'd be working with and the material's caliber. When Shonda Rhimes asked me to be a part of *Scandal*, I didn't need to hear much more than that Shonda was asking me to play the president of the United States with Kerry Washington.

Do you think you'll stay on *Law & Order* for more seasons? It's a mutual thing of "Let's see how it goes," but it certainly seems promising!

SAM'S SIGNOFF

"It's been a hell of a ride," *Law & Order*'s District Attorney Jack McCoy (the renowned Sam Waterston) conceded before performing the heroic prosecutor's version of riding off into the sunset in his February 22 swan song—casting a lingering look back at the New York courthouse where he served justice so nobly for more than 400 episodes of the franchise.

Waterston and McCoy's ride began 30 years ago, and the gray lion proved he still had his courtroom chops when he stepped in for Executive ADA Nolan Price (Hugh Dancy) during a politically sensitive case that made the mayor his sworn enemy. He wins the battle but chooses to resign and spare his staff the risk of political retribution.

McCoy's climactic summation to the jury doubles as a tribute to his own high standards, "to act fairly and ethically, without bias or favor, to always act with integrity."

An admiring Nolan observes, "You haven't lost a step." That's our verdict too. —Matt Roush

stars into the stories. Just a few of the names who have appeared: Juliette Lewis, Mary Steenburgen, Ozzy and Sharon Osbourne, Jason Alexander, Dan Aykroyd, Cheryl Hines, Clark Gregg and wife Jennifer Grey, Peter Gallagher and Mila Kunis. For Goranson, one particular guest goes back to her own childhood. "I was a huge *Pee-wee's Playhouse* fan. And actually, Sarah [Chalke, who shared the role of Becky on *Roseanne*] and I, when we were kids, were invited to have lunch at the Playhouse," she says. "That was such an incredible highlight for us. I absolutely adored Paul Reubens." (For more on the cast members' faves, see sidebar, below.)

Getting to make 100 episodes of television for any show is no easy feat—something Gilbert is well aware of. "I am very grateful people have been watching and supporting us," she says. "It's a rare thing, and I'm very appreciative." That prompts an obvious question: Moving beyond 100 episodes, is there a shelf life to how much longer we can expect the family to make us laugh? According to Helford, the limit does not exist.

"We truly make an effort to have everybody evolve. They don't stay in stasis. They're always growing and changing," he says. "Unless the country suddenly turns around and the lower middle class is living in the big house on the hill, there's a bunch more stories to tell."

All in the Family!

The Conners celebrates 100 entertaining episodes BY JIM HALTERMAN

"IT'S PRETTY SHOCKING, honestly," says Sara Gilbert—not about the latest struggle to befall her onscreen alter ego, Darlene Conner (a role she's portrayed on and off more than 35 years, since the first episode of *Roseanne*), but the fact that *The Conners*, the spinoff of that groundbreaking sitcom, will soon hit its 100th episode. "I think you never expect to make it that far. I certainly didn't."

Though the series has been a staple of ABC's comedy lineup since premiering in 2018, its journey to that celebration is one for the TV history books. After the highly viewed revival of *Roseanne* (the original aired on ABC from 1988 to 1997) was canceled in 2018 following star Roseanne Barr's racist tweets, it seemed all hope was gone for the Conners. But you should never count out the resilient blue-collar family, which, thanks to some

creative storytelling, would go on to see brighter days—just without its matriarch. (Barr's absence was explained by the character dying off camera from an opioid overdose.)

"The idea of the [*Roseanne*] reboot was to clean up the legacy, because the last season wasn't really what everybody

wanted it to be," admits executive producer Bruce Helford. Even before the show became *The Conners*, he thought that the gang would do one season and walk away. Fortunately, the cast and crew started having too much fun—which was a good thing, since renewals kept coming in. "I can't think of any show that rebooted with the entire cast with the exception of one person," says Helford.

So, what's in store for the Lanford, Illinois, household in this milestone episode, airing April 10? "We didn't want to break the kitchen-sink reality that our audience expects, so it was another day in the life of our characters," executive producer Dave Caplan says. On this particular day, "some kids" break into Olinsky's, the hardware store, while Dan (John Goodman) and Jackie (Laurie Metcalf) are there, says Gilbert, also an exec producer.

The unwelcome experience ends up revealing something about sister-in-law Jackie that even patriarch Dan was unaware of. Hint: Part of this revelation is tied to Jackie's past from the original series, when she worked as a cop. Helford is proud of this kind of storytelling, which he says contributes to the show's longevity. "Even after 100 episodes, these characters are still finding things out about each other. The relationships are still evolving, and that's what makes it fun and rewarding," he says.

Elsewhere in the episode, Becky's (Lecy Goranson) inquisitive 6-year-old daughter, Beverly Rose (Charlotte San-

chez), finds a box of old family photographs. "There are relatives we can't identify [in the pictures], which leads to a discussion about death," Gilbert says. "Darlene is overly honest, and it creates fear in Beverly Rose and a rift between Becky and Darlene." That sisterly conflict has existed since the original series began and, according to Goranson, is "the gift that keeps on giving." It's also what fans respond to most with the actress. "They say to me, 'Oh, my gosh, this is me and my sister!'" Goranson notes. "It's that love-hate thing, that sibling rivalry."

Another key to *The Conners'* success: consistently folding memorable guest

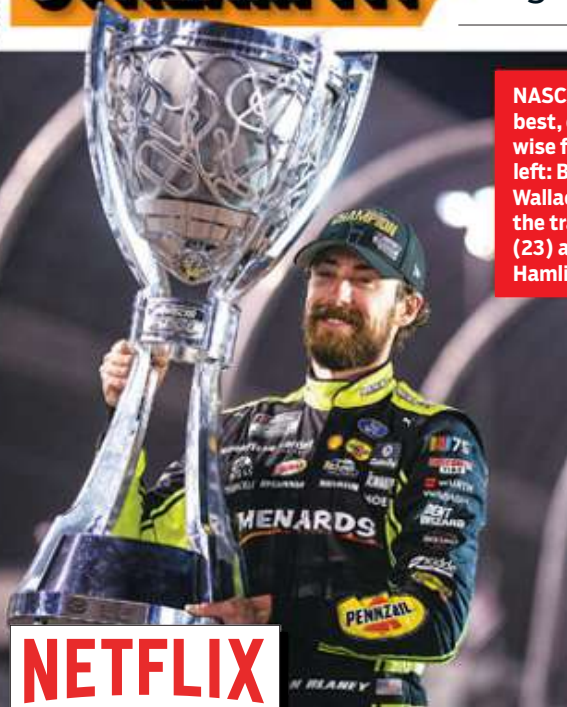

NASCAR: Full Speed

ORIGINAL DOCUSERIES For decades, NASCAR has offered a squeaky-clean motorsports product, letting its horsepower and rivalries do most of the talking. Recently, ratings and attendance have flattened or dropped. But expect that to change thanks to *NASCAR: Full Speed*, a docu-series in the mold of Netflix's popular *Formula 1: Drive to Survive*. These five episodes show drivers for who they are—humorous, tough-talking, vulnerable humans willing to knock their fellows out of the way if it means winning. The series focuses on the elite stars during the Cup Series' final 10-week stretch, with cameras spending more time showing contenders off the track than on. It has gotten people talking—including word of a potential Season 2. "You have to change with the times," says Ryan Blaney, whose capture of the

championship ends the finale. "I think NASCAR has gotten into their heads that we have to continue to evolve." One thing that hasn't changed is racing's blend of driver archetypes. Denny Hamlin, the successful 18-year vet, is still chasing an elusive first championship. Hamlin co-owns the two-driver 23XI Racing team with NBA great Michael Jordan (Bubba Wallace, the Cup's only Black driver, is on the roster), and his comments about favoring the team he owns over the one he races for make for spirited viewing. A pair of younger stars—recent Daytona 500 winner William Byron and sixth-year Cup driver Ross Chastain—have interesting backstories. And Joey Logano, 2022 Cup champ, gets screen time. Producers knew they'd need to take chances on certain racers. "Chastain didn't have a very successful playoffs, so

his arc is one episode," says Aaron Cohen, an exec producer on the series. If they did another season, Cohen adds, "I think we'd bring in different characters." They'd have more takers, given that racers were pleased with how they were portrayed. Says Chastain, "I just asked them to not make me regret letting them in, and they showed [everything] in a good way." NASCAR has tried non-racing series such as this before, "but when it became a Netflix opportunity, that changed things," says Dale Earnhardt Jr., Hall of Fame driver and NBC motorsports analyst. "[Drivers] knew the potential opportunities would be good." Needless to say, Blaney is sold. "Whether you're a diehard fan or a new fan, it gives you something to learn," says the new champ. "And obviously, I like the ending." —Robert Edelstein

PICK OF THE WEEK! WHAT A RESCUE! After Fox axed 9-1-1 right before the writers' strike last summer, ABC snapped up the drama about Los Angeles' first responders. And seven seasons in, these heroes remain as disaster movie—ready as ever. “I have discovered that [showrunner] Tim Minear has aspired to be television's Irwin Allen,” says Peter Krause, referencing the “Master of Disaster” ’70s filmmaker, “because we’ve done an earthquake, a tidal wave....” (Note: Krause's LAFD captain Bobby Nash has also endured a burning blimp, a landslide and a blackout!)

Now, to make a splash in their new home, “we’re doing *The Poseidon Adventure* and making no mystery of it,” Minear says, adding that the opening minutes feature “an absolute tribute to Irwin Allen.” As viewers know, Bobby and his wife, LAPD sergeant Athena Grant-Nash (Angela Bassett, right, with Krause), are setting sail on a belated honeymoon cruise. (Expect to see a couple of familiar faces on board.) Things take a titanic turn when pirates seize the ship, leading to a massive explosion and an all-hands-on-deck effort to avoid capsizing and sinking into the Pacific.

Meanwhile, for the gang at Bobby's Station 118, Minear promises “another great disaster” inspired by a real-life case: “A fighter pilot had to bail out of his plane—and they didn't know where the plane went.”

In addition to the series' big 100th episode in April, emotional off-duty stories are continued, including what Oliver Stark calls “a season of self-discovery” for his reckless firefighter Evan “Buck” Buckley and the long-overdue wedding of Buck's sister, call-center operator Maddie Buckley (Jennifer Love Hewitt), to the LAFD's Howard “Chimney” Han (Kenneth Choi).

In fact, it's these character-driven dramas—and not the often insane calamities—that have become the real heart of the show. “This is a family of people who work together and love each other through thick and through thin,” Krause notes. “And because this is a comic book about first responders come to life, it's mostly thick.” —*Damian Holbrook*

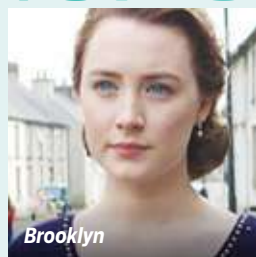

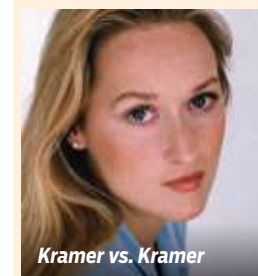

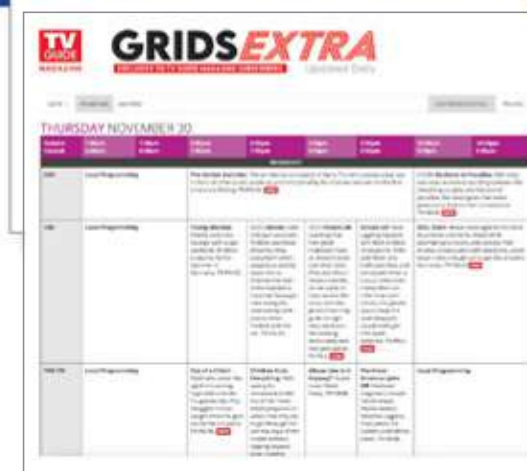

Top Chef

SEASON PREMIERE Wednesday, March 20, 9/8c, Bravo

THERE ARE PLENTY of changes in Season 21 of Bravo's foodie hit, which opens with chefs from around the country headed to America's Dairyland, Wisconsin. Viewers will not only be treated to the new locale and supersized installments but also a fresh host, as Kristen Kish (*Top Chef* Season 10 winner and host of National Geographic's *Restaurants at the End of the World*) takes over for Padma Lakshmi, who left the show after 17 years.

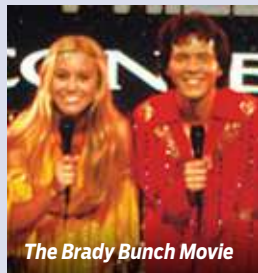
The Midwest is home for the Korean-born Kish (above left, in a cranberry marsh with judges Tom Colicchio and Gail Simmons in the May 15 episode), who was adopted and raised in Michigan and attended culinary school in Chicago. She knew she would be in her comfort zone in Milwaukee and Madison, where the majority of filming took place. "It kind of feels like a homecoming in more ways than one," the chef says.

We took a trip to the *Top Chef* set while they were shooting a cheese festival on a blisteringly hot August day (the episode airs April 10). The chefs were tasked with creating a cheese-inspired plate, with some of Wisconsin's award-winning cheesemakers

serving as judges. Some drool-worthy dishes we sampled included a fried potato and cheese curd dripping in gravy and a Gorgonzola crab Rangoon salad with rice chips. That deliciousness is just the start. This season's challenges involve the Milwaukee Brewers' Famous Racing Sausages (yes, the baseball team's costume-wearing wieners got involved!) and "chaos"-style cuisine with *The Bear*'s Matty Matheson. "Being able to explore [Wisconsin] through the eyes of *Top Chef* and the challenges that we're doing has been really great," admits Kish.

At stake for the 15 talented cheftestants—composed of James Beard nominees, Michelin-starred kitchen alums and even a former *Top Chef France* finalist—is not only the coveted title of *Top Chef* but \$250,000 cash. And there will be more chances to rack up the dough this year. Instead of earning an immunity for winning a Quickfire Challenge, a cash prize will be awarded. Colicchio and Simmons will also be joining Kish at Quickfire Challenges during the back half of the season. Now that's turning up the heat! —Barb Oates

But here, he picks up a scalpel as *Chicago Med*'s newest emergency doctor, Mitch Ripley (above). Ripley's dark past as an ex-juvie was revealed when he first saw psychiatrist Daniel Charles (Oliver Platt) in the ED. To Ripley, the caring doc treated him for anger issues but abandoned him.

Earlier this season, viewers gained even more insight into Ripley's psyche when Sully (Daniel Dorr), his former partner in crime, arrived at Med. "Sully represents who Ripley used to be, and in some ways still is, regardless of his white

lab coat," Mitchell says. "He's a very skilled doctor, but you'll see that there is a lot going on beneath the surface."

Tonight, Ripley and Charles treat a patient with an OCD diagnosis—together. "The relationship continues to be push and pull," explains Mitchell. "But this is a real opportunity for them to communicate and work on their trust."

Ripley is also potentially looking for love, and a flirtation begins. "There's an undercurrent between Ripley and Dr. Hannah Asher [Jessy Schram], an attraction that's worth exploring," says Mitchell. But could Asher's deepening friendship with Dr. Dean Archer (Steven Weber) get in the way? —*Ileane Rudolph*

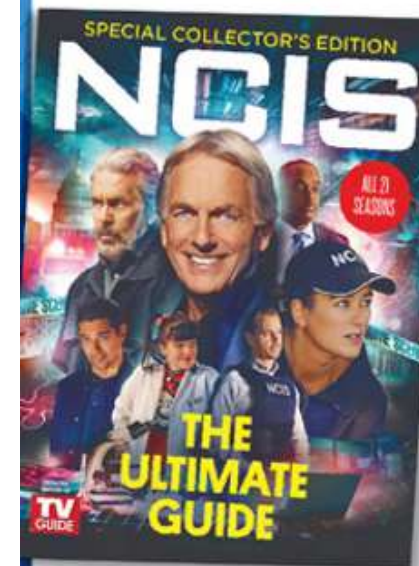

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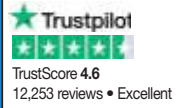

A Gentleman in Moscow

SERIES PREMIERE Sunday, March 31, 9/8c, Paramount+ With Showtime

ANNA URBANOVA, PLAYED with statuesque confidence by Mary Elizabeth Winstead, makes quite the entrance in this lush period drama. Or rather, her borzois do: The elegant but unruly dogs upend tables and patrons in the fine-dining restaurant at Moscow's Hotel Metropol, where Count Alexander Rostov (a stately and vulnerable Ewan McGregor) is, by law, confined. The count quickly settles the pups down, but one look at Anna, in her feather headdress and backless gown, and it's his heart that's really tamed.

"I read [Amor Towles' 2016 novel], and Ewan and I started going, 'Oh, this could be a great role for me'—plus, the prospect of working together," Winstead says of joining her husband in the eight-

episode project, which she calls "a dream. Anna is such a survivor. She goes to so many places in her life."

The opposite is true of Rostov. In the opening moments—set in 1921, a few years after the Russian Revolution—the aristocratic count is sentenced to spend the rest of his life in the hotel. Should he ever leave, he'll be shot on sight. While occupying cramped servants' quarters, Rostov slowly begins to appreciate the value of a simple existence as he befriends a slew of fascinating hotel staffers. Tortured by memories of his past and taunted by a Russian secret police officer (Johnny Harris, *Great Expectations*), he is saved from despair by his bond with the imaginative young

daughter of a widowed bureaucrat (Alexa Goodall, above right, with Winstead and McGregor) and his growing love for Anna. Through them, even in isolation, his world opens up.

"I think what Ewan captures so well is the count has this personality where he can overcome many things," Winstead says. For both her and McGregor, who met in 2016 while playing opposite each other in *Fargo*'s third season, falling in love onscreen was also a thrill. "We'd have days when we were absolutely emotional wrecks, potentially saying goodbye to each other," she says of the characters. "We were building this kind of quiet life together." Barking dogs notwithstanding. —Robert Edelstein

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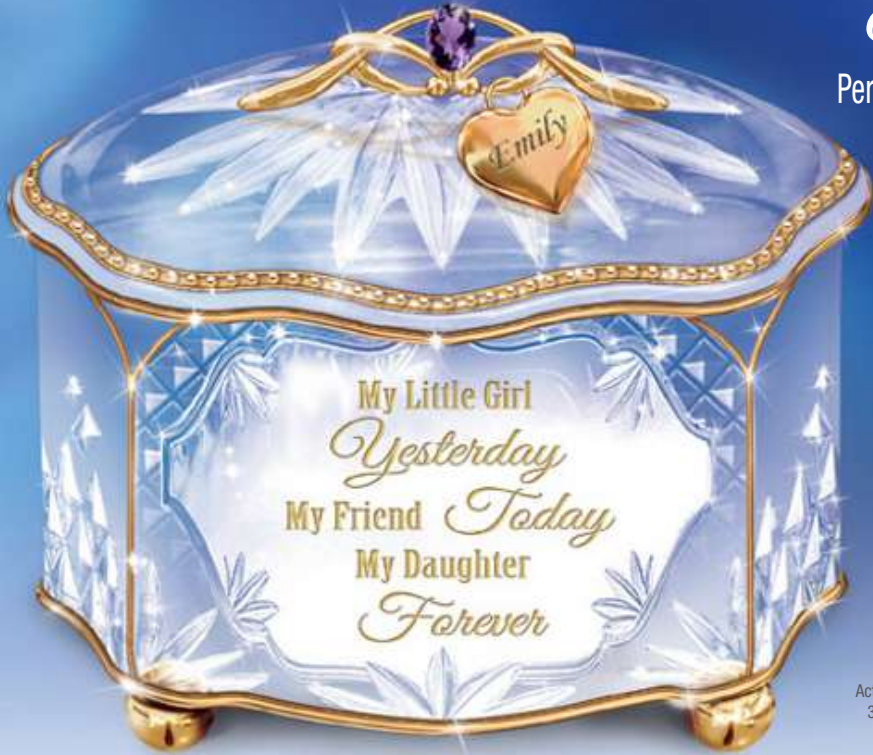

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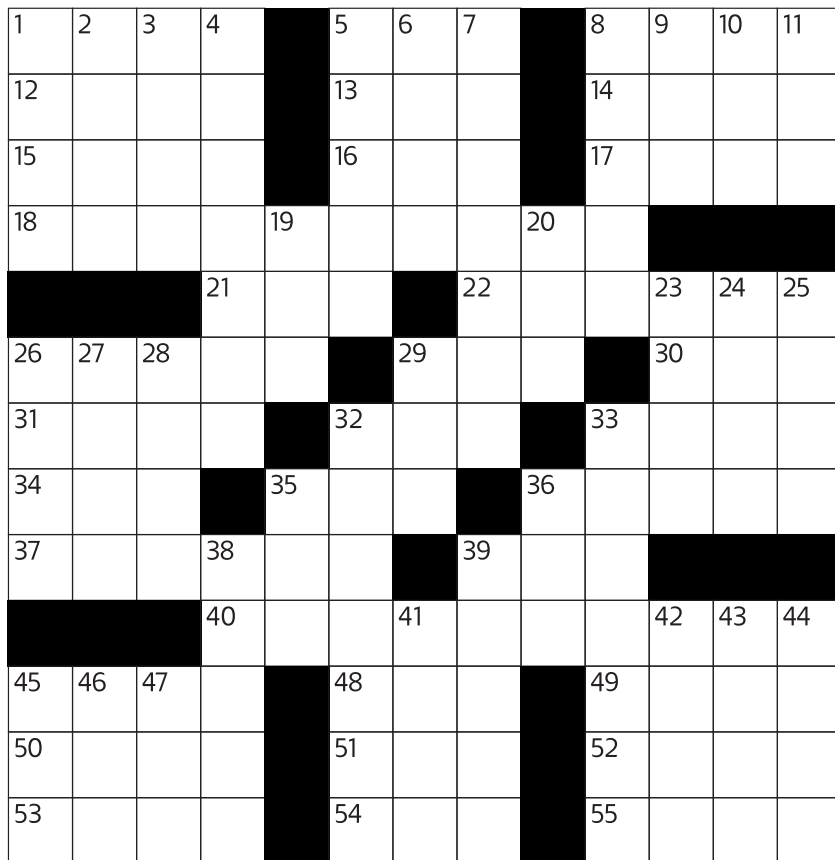

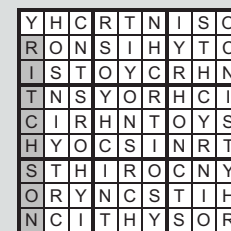
